New Business

- Tackle the Town
  - July 21, 2018 at Maddie's Biergarten from 5:00-9:00 p.m. but can stay as long as you want
  - John Saunders Band is booked to play
  - Need live and silent auction items: trips, overnight stays, golf, etc.
  - Baskets: will try to have each class develop a themed basket and will ask everyone to donate toward their class basket. Maybe a competition between classes: the class with the basket that sells for the most money gets a pizza party or something
  - The Club will get a percentage back from the food and beverage sales at Maddie's, based on how many people come. We don't have to pay for the venue, alcohol, or food. It is a win-win
  - Auction will run from 5:00 – 8:00
  - Will pre-sell VIP tickets: receive a bier stein, free drink ticket. Will sell at the door too. Drinks tickets are how Maddie's knows how many people we bring in. Anyone off the street can support us too
  - No entrance fee. Open to the public
  - Advertising the event
  - Barbara has finalized the logo
  - Auction items in the back room. Maddie's staff will "guard" it. We will need volunteers as well to work at various stations during the night. Sign ups will go out. Volunteer hours go toward your family volunteer hours
- Community Events
  - Only one community event had availability, so we are bringing the Purple Bus to the grand opening of Festival Park on June 2. Starts at 2:00 p.m. Movie starts at dusk

  - Town is having Brews event after the parade until 4:00 p.m. If we can have the booth at the firehouse until then, will help sell Huskie Cards
  - Town will email Brian when they open up registration for the Parade and he can register us then.
